

Why you can make change happen – without investing any money

- You as a donor - or future donor have a very strong influence and responsibility for what happens with your money: Because you decide to whom you trustfully remit your money

- It lays in your own hands to put the organisations under pressure by strictly urging them to protect the sponsored children from violence like female genital mutilation.

- You have direct influence to the organizations' strategies. You can help causing a change to their priorities. To reach this, you do not even need to spend a single cent, but you only have to clearly call for that – and to consequently act if they do not respond to your requests, because:

- The organisations want your money. They depend on people like you who are willing to contribute to make this world a better place, and who would like to make a donation for one or more sponsored children:

If you - and many other donors – will stand together for the same objective, if you all call for true and lasting protection of the sponsored girls from genital mutilation, the organisations will have to respond quite promptly.

If you prove to the organisations how seriously you mean it, for instance by canceling your current sponsorship contracts - until the organisations guarantee the girls' protection – you will help to push this process of change a lot..

And if you are a future donor, you can make clear to the organisations that you will take over a sponsorship only under the condition that the girls' protection from FGM is guaranteed.
